 - 10 new models onboarded and admin processes updated and managed by Alex
 - Started using Calendly to book models reduces email
 - Drop in payment pilot happening now

Xchanges artist-run-centre

Xchanges Artists Gallery and Studios is located on unceded Coast Salish territories aka Victoria, BC, founded in 1967. xchangesgallery.org

- Projects
 - Studio artists initiating Good Neighbourhood Project – City of Vic funding of \$5K toward improvements outside (TBD) - didn't happen. Try again.
 - Physical Intersections Digital Collaborations kicked off in September 2022. This project is bringing good opportunities for the Community Partnership of Xchanges, MediaNet/Flux Gallery, and Victoria Arts Council (Alex Jensen – Intern full report attached)
 - Community Partnerships in search of a home for Xchanges and other arts community members
 - Presentation to Victoria Foundation with a business case to support 4 core members (Xchanges, VAC, MediaNet/Flus, and Vancouver Island School of Art) and other groups (potentially up to 15 groups) - well received and moving forward! Long range plan to address space, capacity, location instability of rising rents etc. Potential \$4M in funding





CHALLENGES, Issues and Opportunities, BIG Questions

- Covid-19 continued to impact every aspect of Xchanges operations, but we had some major new successes:
 - Excellent and diverse exhibition program ^(C)
 - Healthy turnout of diverse submissions for next season
 - Disruption of studios/turnover (8)
- Board struggled with attendance, consistency, gaps ⊗⊗
- Rent and overhead costs have gone way up. Studio rental increases take effect June 1, 2023

Transformation Goals – continues to be focused on the need to diversify income and funding

- **Completed** another CRD extended funding grant application and BC Gaming Grant application thank you Cindy!
- Applied for Covid Relief funding from Red Cross to support continuation of Alex's role and graduate him from Intern to full staff Heidi
- Plans to apply for BCAC and Canada Council project funding support Gallery operations and special projects like artist talks, artist development workshop (how to write a bio, CV, artist statement etc.)
- Moving Life Drawing operations toward drop-in again purchased a Square Terminal so participants can pay by tap of debit/credit have started pilot with Wednesday mornings, but still have limited capacity.

Opportunities

- Use the 1x per month in Gallery for paid pop ups need to advertise
- Increase Life Drawing sessions
- Increase promotion we need volunteers to help with social media and we also need to spend more on paid advertising
- Social Enterprise Still on the Table presented to the Board and at the AGM last year. Xchanges new Board to consider final data received about buying a business that can help support Xchanges operations. Presentation for new Board in May 2023.
